**Parish Council Meetings**

The next meeting of Tabley Parish Council will be held Monday 21st July 2014 at Tabley Parish Hall, Old Hall Lane at 7.30pm.

**Tabley Parish Hall Consultation**

Every resident of Tabley received a letter from the Parish Council informing them of the consultation regarding the future of Tabley Parish Hall. With the Highways Agencies plans to build the new road 10 metres away from the current Hall, it is agreed that the Hall's present location will be untenable and the consultation was to establish what the residents of Tabley would prefer:-

- Mere Parish Club developed
- The building of a new Hall in Tabley

The results of the consultation are as follows:-

Of the 153 consultation letters sent out 32 responses were received, just a 21% response.

21 residents preferred the Mere Parish Club to be Developed  
11 residents preferred the rebuilding of Tabley Parish Hall

Prior to the consultation, Tabley Parish Council searched for suitable land in Tabley and consulted with various land owners trying to find a location where a new Tabley Parish Hall could be built. Unfortunately, no land was available.

Members of Tabley Parish Council are meeting with Highways Agency trying to ensure that if the new A556 road does go ahead that Tabley receives appropriate compensation for not only the loss of a community facility, but also for the disruption and yet loss of more countryside in the Parish.

## The Orchard on Holly Grove

Tabley residents may be aware that when the new houses were built last year on Holly Grove a sum of £24,000, known as Section 106 funding, was made available by the developers for improving community facilities on the street. A small group of residents (Sarah Carson and Helen Gurney - Smith, who are both Holly Grove residents and Parish Councillors, as well as residents Rod Oates and Helen Wither) have been meeting to take this work forward.

Before Christmas, people living on Holly Grove were asked door-to-door what facilities they would like to see provided. Over half of residents wanted to see facilities for children, including equipment for older youngsters (e.g. sport/basketball) as well as a younger children's play area. Residents also wanted paths, planted areas, benches and bins to deal with dog waste left in the orchard. We feel it is important to cater not just for children but for adult residents who may want to enjoy this community space and use it as a place to relax and socialise.

With the support of Cheshire East Council we are looking at a number of additional grant applications to increase our pot of money, including from WREN (Waste Recycling Environmental Ltd) scheme for areas close to landfill sites and from the Manchester Airport Communities Fund. To apply for more funding we are hoping to set up a residents' group called Friends Of Holly Grove, which everyone on Holly Grove will be invited to join.

The next step will be for Cheshire East to go to tender on our behalf for a company to develop the recreational area (this will be done in conjunction with playground schemes for other areas in Cheshire East). Once we have an appointed company we will need to work with residents to make sure that what they come up with reflects the needs of people on Holly Grove. If you have any ideas about what should be provided in the orchard, the playground group would love to hear from you (and especially from the

### The late Mrs Lily Rosen of 23 Holly Grove

The funeral took place on 19<sup>th</sup> May of Mrs Lily Rosen of no 23 Holly Grove, who died on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2014 at the wonderful age of 99 years.

Mrs Rosen had lived on Holly Grove for 64 years, moving in to the old houses in 1950. She was a well known and much loved character on Holly Grove, often to be seen sweeping her front step, hanging laundry and tending her lovely, tidy garden. She also enjoyed sneaking a chocolate biscuit to the children when they visited – happy, sticky faces and fingers would give the game away to parents and grandparents afterwards!

Mrs Rosen was fit and active and lived independently to the end of her life. A number of neighbours attended the funeral service at Altrincham crematorium and some of those who were unable to attend stood on the street to pay their respects as the funeral cortege made its way out of Holly Grove. Mrs Rosen will be much missed by her friends and neighbours.

Our thoughts are with Tony and the family at this sad time.

### Broadband Update

According to the map, most of Tabley is ready to use the superfast service. Excited by this news, I submitted my phone number into the system, only to be informed that in fact I did not have access to the new service.

It seems that Tabley doesn't have any green roadside cabinets and this is essential to provide the new service.

The target of the Connecting Cheshire project is to have 96% of premises in Cheshire, Halton and Warrington able to access superfast broadband by Summer 2015.

I was advised that we should keep asking our Internet Service Provider when we will be able to access the new system.
