Tabley Parish Hall Consultation

Every resident of Tabley received a letter from the Parish Council informing them of the consultation regarding the future of Tabley Parish Hall. With the Highways Agencies plans to build the new road 10 metres away from the current Hall, it is agreed that the Hall's present location will be untenable and the consultation was to establish what the residents of Tabley would prefer:-

- Mere Parish Club developed
- The building of a new Hall in Tabley

HS2 Consultation Road shows at Tatton Park

Members of Tabley Parish Council will be attending a closed meeting with George Osborne on 13th December. The object of this meeting is to highlight the concerns of the local Parish Councils regarding this proposal.

The government launched a formal public consultation on the proposed route for HS2 earlier this year. This consultation is open until 5pm on 31st January.

Special veterans service at Manchester Airport Concorde Hangar

Veterans and Cadets from all three Services remembered those who gave their lives in conflict at Manchester Airport Aviation Park on 8th November.

The Special Veterans Service also marked the 75th anniversary of the Airport this year. Bands from 70 (Croft & Culcheth) Squadron and 162 (Stockport) Squadron provided musical entertainment for the guests. Cadets from 145 (Alt'ham & Hale) Squadron gave a drill display. The Sea Cadet Corps & Marine Cadet Corps from Stockport and Sale & Altrincham Units joined up with Air Cadets to Demonstrate a guard of honour.

A traditional Service of Remembrance followed which was led by Rev George Lane, Manchester Airport Chaplain.

Manchester Airport played an important part during the WWII. Known as RAF Ringway, plenty of action took place at the airfield including the Maiden Flight of the prototype Lancaster Bomber. It also became an established Parachute Training School and Parachute Brigades, on orders from Winston Churchill, were formed and trained at Ringway and the surrounding countryside, especially at Tatton Park. Foreign Parachute Brigades were also dispatched to RAF Ringway for training, including the Polish Airborne, the French Foreign Legion together with members of the Special Operations Executive.

The Women's Royal Auxiliary Air Force also played an important role as Parachute packers.

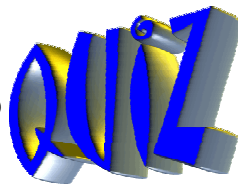
