**Manchester Airport Meeting  
Councillor Graham Bowen**

Manchester Airport regularly invite local Parish Councils to attend a meeting to inform them of any developments that might be happening now or in the future.

Councillor Withenshaw and myself attended on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> March. The topics included :

The purchase of Stansted Airport

- Night noise policy
- Community relations
- Electronic Communications
- Security overview and training, which included awareness of their threats, and a visit to the "toy shop", where we were shown a display of confiscated items.

- Planning Developments, which included Airport City and Transport.

The transport presentation sparked many questions about HS2. They said that although they are in favour of an integrated national transport scheme, they are in the same position as everyone else. They do not own the land where the proposed station is to be built and they have not asked for the line to service the airport.

The Airport have an outreach programme, where members of the public can attend to discuss anything. These meetings are held regularly at Knutsford Library during the day. Full details can be found at [manchesterairport.co.uk/keepingintouch](http://manchesterairport.co.uk/keepingintouch).

**Cheshire County Show to  
celebrate it's 175th anniversary**

**As Cheshire Agricultural society celebrates its 175th anniversary organisers of the Cheshire County Show are gearing up for another action-packed event at the Tabley Showground on June 18 and 19.**

With its roots firmly embedded in Cheshire's rich farming history the main focus of the show will once again be the animals including the English National Show for Simmental cattle and a first class at the event for South Devon cattle.

There will also be thousands of other livestock, horses and dogs in competition.

The Sainsbury's Agri-Centre will also keep the show's agricultural heritage alive with the wider public as members of the county's farming community demonstrate the methods used to get foodstuffs on to supermarket shelves.

In addition to the animals the public will get the chance see a variety of rural past times including falconry and a pack of hounds in the Countryside Experience Area.

A thrilling schedule is planned for the main ring where attractions will include a heart-stopping display by leading stunt motorcyclists Matt Coulter AKA 'The Kangaroo Kid' and live music from the Scots Guard Association Pipe and Drum Band.

Visitors will also be able to sample to culinary delights of the Roberts Speciality Food Hall and Food Live Theatre. The ever popular Cheese Section, which attracts over 300 entries from producers across the country, is also sponsored this year by Booths Supermarkets.
