Parish Council Meetings

The next meeting of Tabley Parish Council will be held Monday 8th September 2014 at Tabley Parish Hall, Old Hall Lane at 7.30pm.

A556 Knutsford to Bowdon Improvement Scheme

At the last Parish Council meeting, two representatives from Costain attended and gave an update on the plans if and when the Secretary of State makes a decision about the new A556 highway.

The Secretary of State made his decision on 28th August and has granted consent to the A556 Knutsford to Bowdon Improvement Scheme. It is expected that work will commence on the project in November 2014. A copy of the Secretary of State for Transport's letter can be viewed on the Parish Council's website.

Costain gave an update on the plans for the de-trunked area of the A556 affecting Tabley (the current highway between M6 junction 19 and Mere lights) advising that the Manchester bound lanes will be for none motorized units, pedestrians, cyclists and horses and the Chester bound lanes will have speed restrictions on them between 30 and 50 mph. It is expected that Old Hall Lane will be closed for one year whilst the work takes place.

Parish Hall

Following the decision made by the Secretary of State, Tabley Parish Council are now trying to establish the fete of Tabley Parish Hall. As soon as there is any news regarding these plans, they will be published on the Parish Council's website.

HS2

At present there are no new details about the affect HS2 will have on Tabley, however members of Tabley Parish Council will attending an update session in the forthcoming weeks any appropriate information will be included on the Parish Council's website.

Plans for the new play area at the rear of the houses in Holly Grove are going well, and it is hoped that work on the first stage of project will comment in the very near future.

The second stage will follow as soon as any grants and matched funding has been acquired and these funds will provide more equipment and facilities for this area.
