### Parish Council Meetings

The next meeting of Tabley Parish Council will be held Monday 10th November 2014 at Tabley Parish Hall, Old Hall Lane at 7.30pm.

### **A556 Knutsford to Bowdon Improvement Scheme**

As mentioned in last months newsletter, the Secretary of State granted consent for the A56 Knutsford to Bowdon Improvement Scheme to commence. Work is due to commence this month, however it is hoped that disruption to traffic along the A556 will be kept to a minimum whilst work takes place.

As part of the work, Old Hall Lane will be closed for approximately a year, closing after the Cheshire Show in June and reopening in time for the 2016 Show.

### **Parish Hall**

As most of you will be aware, consent for the link road was given at the end of August. We have maintained all along that the Parish Hall will not be viable in its present location. Not being able to find a location in Tabley, it was voted two to one to spend any compensatory monies at Mere Parish Club. After negotiations with Mere estate, who own the Parish Club, a 50 year lease has been offered to the committee of the Club. This it was felt, was as long as we could expect. We at Tabley are currently engaging a valuer to act for the Village Hall committee in negotiations with the Highways Agency, to obtain the best possible deal for our community. The main contractors to build the new road, Costains, will we hope give us some contribution towards the project at Mere. The whole process should move on quickly now, as the Highways Agency have indicated that possession of the Parish Hall site would be in May of next year. Be assured that Tabley and Mere Parish Councils and the Village Hall committee are doing their utmost to obtain a fair deal for our community.

### **Cheshire Show**

Following the issues with the traffic management on the first day of the 2014 Cheshire County Show, organisers are working with the traffic management contractor throughout the winter months to identify areas of concern with a view to developing an improved plan for the 2015 show. Nigel Evans, Executive Director stated that this improved plan will prevent the severe disruption endured at this year's show in the future and thanked local residents for their patience and tolerance of what was a totally unacceptable situation this year.

### **HS2**

At present there are no new details about the affect HS2 will have on Tabley. However, we understand that no final decision will be made until after the General Election in May 2015.

## Manchester Airport

Manchester Airport reported receipt of complaints about delays and long queues at the passenger security area. This was due to an increase in passenger numbers coinciding with the new rules on electrical equipment. Extra x-ray machines are being installed and more staff are being recruited and this will be in place in time for the Christmas rush.

There is a new Track Monitoring System which is being developed to monitor all flights and will enable the airport authorities and members of the public to track and monitor noise levels of individual planes. More information will be available in the future.

In order to deliver the fourth heavy rail platform at Manchester Airport there will need to be some restrictions to our current capacity and an all out closure of the Rail Station:

Platform 3 will be closed from 8:45 am on Sunday 11th to 1:20 am Saturday 17th January 2015.

During this time fewer services will run directly to Manchester Airport; a number will cease at Manchester Piccadilly or be diverted to Wilmslow. The whole Station will be closed from 1:20 am on Saturday 17th January to 4 am on Monday 9th February 2015. For more information please see the temporary timetable that will be issued in advance.

Replacement bus services will run during the closures:

-Northern services will run to Heald Green, with a replacement bus service to the airport.

-Transpennine Express services will terminate at Manchester Piccadilly (15 min frequency bus service to the Airport).

**Community Outreach** is a scheme whereby members of the public can raise any issues about the airport at various locations in the area.
